All Oral Presenters

Please bring your presentation as a PowerPoint file on a PC-compatible USB drive that has been checked for viruses.

If you prefer to connect your own PC/Mac laptop, please bring a USB drive as a back-up. The projector has laptop connections for HDMI, VGA, and mini-display port. Remember to bring a power cable and any necessary adapters. A slide advancer/laser pointer and power strip will be provided.

All presenters should check-in with Lexi Nash during the break prior to their session to load their PowerPoint onto the computer or connect their laptop. For example, (20+5) means 20 minutes presentation and 5 minutes discussion time. Please complete your presentation data in English.

All Poster Presenters

All poster presenters are required to check-in at the registration desk to receive their poster number. Poster area is prepared in front of the Symposium hall.

Poster presentation is required to stand by your own poster at the presentation time. Posters will not be attended by volunteers.
